Regarding your message registered with the National Authority for Management and Regulation in Communications of Romania under no. SC-9419/22.04.2013, we are able to offer you the following information:

INTERNET TELECOM's right to use the national numbers in the 1000 number block 0903.720.XXX (X = 0,1, ..., 9) ceased on 10.03.2011. Afterwards, this block of numbers was allotted by ANCOM to VOCALNET COMMUNICATION (through Licence no. 180.1/20.07.2011).

The 09XX.XXX.XXX national numbers included in the National Numbering Plan (NNP), adopted by Decision no. 2895/2007, are reserved for providing Premium Rate services.

By means of the national numbers in the 0903.XXX.XXX range, the providers can offer content services such as: information (general, business, marketing, usage etc.), entertainment, games and contests. These numbers are defined in accordance with the Recommendation ITU - T E.164 – The international public telecommunication numbering plan.

International calls to these numbers can be originated by dialing the international number +40.903.XXX.XXX, preceded (as the case may be) by the carrier selection code. There are no clauses in Romanian normative acts forbidding international calls to the Premium Rate dedicated numbers of our NNP. The international access to these numbers is strictly a commercial issue that depends on the interconnection agreements between providers.

On the other hand, the Decision no. 2895/2007 clearly states that Premium Rate numbers are to be used for supplying services at fixed locations situated on the territory of Romania (i.e. calls to this type of numbers must be terminated on the territory of Romania).
