

# Memorandum of Understanding

**ITS Israel and ITS South Africa**



## **A Forum for Bilateral Cooperation in Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) to Support Membership Value and International Relations**

The purpose of this memorandum of understanding is to establish a bilateral relationship and develop cooperation between ITS Israel and ITS South Africa (the parties) in important matters pertaining to ITS research, planning, and deployment in the two countries. Particular attention will be given to improving membership value and promoting research, educational, and commercial cooperation between the parties.

With this framework, ITS professionals and industries will better understand the potential for ITS and thus be able to optimize the development and deployment of ITS in their respective countries. Therefore, through this memorandum of understanding, the parties set down the following principles:

- Exchange of ITS information and technical publications as agreed between the two parties.
- Exchange and dialogue regarding the possible facilitation of ITS professionals and organizations from both private and public sectors who wish to make contact or visits to ITS development and implementation sites in Israel and South Africa.
- Exchange and dialogue among ITS Israel and ITS South Africa volunteer leadership and staff regarding effective association management practices.
- Exchange and dialogue on policy issues to benefit ITS professionals and industries around the world.
- Cooperative promotion of each other's principal ITS events.

This Memorandum does not preclude any of the parties from participating in relationships with other ITS entities.

Expectations for the future are that the co-operation among the parties will be highly beneficial for both organizations and that this agreement may lead to more effective and better organized development and deployment of intelligent transportation systems in Israel and South Africa.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall come into effect the day of respective signatures and may be terminated unilaterally by any of the parties by means of the terminating party giving one month's notice to the other party to this agreement.
