Game Rules

Play With...

3 to 6 players. Age: 5 and up.

What's in the Box?

36 Cards, divided into nine series of four cards each, and game Rules.

Preparing the Game

Shuffle the cards thoroughly, and deal the entire deck equally among the players. Do not mind if a player is dealt one card more or less.

Ready, Steady, Go...

Each player looks at his cards and tries to put together a series of four cards. A series is comprised of four cards showing four preparation stages of a food product. The illustration in the big circle indicates the series the card belongs to. A player completing a series of four cards places it face up on the table. After all players sorted their cards, the game can begin. The dealer goes first. He turns to one of the players and asks for a certain card. First, he will ask if he has cards from a specific series, according to the illustration in the circle, if the answer is "Yes", he continues to ask for a specific card, indicating the color of the desired card.

A player may request a specific card only if it has at least one card in the series.

If the player asked has that specific card, he must give it to the asking player. If the answer is "No", the asking player loses his turn, and the turn goes to the player he asked for the card. A player receiving the requested card, keeps playing and may ask the same player again or any other player. The game continues until all the quartets are completed.

And Who Wins?

The game is over when there are no more cards in the players' hands, and each player has a number of quartets in front of him. The winner is the player who has completed the largest number of quartets.
